





This BIGFOOT chassis is the newest member of the Team BIGFOOT fleet. It was completed on December 24, 2014, and did its first live event in Southaven, MS (Memphis, TN) on January 9 and 10, 2015, winning a race and freestyle that very first weekend with legendary driver Dan Runte behind the wheel and even winning the Toughest Monster Truck Tour Championship that first year, and again the next year. It employs many of the features that made the earlier BIGFOOT #18 successful, with some tweaks and improvements. It has a low center of gravity chassis, long-travel shocks, and an even longer wheelbase than the earlier BIGFOOT trucks. This BIGFOOT also utilizes "zoomie" headers, giving it a very loud and unique sound as compared to other BIGFOOT trucks. 

#### Coal & Coke Trail

As we enjoy the Scottdale Fall Festival, it's a great time to celebrate another local gem: the Coal & Coke Trail. This trail is more than a scenic path, it's a neighborhood connector that weaves through town and history all at once.

Stretching just over 5 miles from Mount Pleasant to Scottdale, the trail rides along the old Pennsylvania Railroad corridor once used to haul coal and coke out of Scottdale and across the region. Now, it offers residents and visitors a peaceful way to walk, bike, jog, or even cross-country ski in winter; among woods, creeks, and quiet rail-trail charm.

What makes the Coal & Coke Trail special is how it connects people. Local volunteers (through the Coal & Coke Trail Chapter of the Regional Trail Corporation) maintain it, run clean-ups, hold family events, and even plan fun fundraisers like Comedy Night to keep it vibrant and maintained. On National Trails Day this past summer, they hosted a community hike/bike from both Scottdale and Mount Pleasant trailheads. It was a beautiful example of how the trail brings neighbors together.

Along the way, the trail passes by Jacob's Creek, winding through shaded woodlands, wetlands, and even remnants of old coke ovens. These historic touches remind us of Scottdale's roots in the coal and coke industry that once powered America's steel mills.

Whether you're walking your dog, training for a 5K, taking the kids out for a stroll, or enjoying a leisurely bike ride, the Coal & Coke Trail is a friendly, local route that's easy to explore, right in our own backyard. It's one of those simple joys that makes small-town life feel rich.




